The Lebowitz Prize

Nomination Form

The Dr. Martin R. Lebowitz and Eve Lewellis Lebowitz Prize for Philosophical Achievement and Contribution, as well as the associated Lebowitz Symposium, awarded by The Phi Beta Kappa Society in conjunction with the American Philosophical Association, is presented annually at a Divisional meeting of the APA.

The Symposium program shall ordinarily consist of a lecture to be delivered at an annual meeting of one of the divisions of the APA as selected by the honorees, or lacking their agreement, by the PBK Society. The topic of the lectures should be an important philosophical issue of current interest, be of a general interest outside of the field of philosophy, and should offer contrasting (not necessarily opposing) views on that topic.

Honoraria for the symposiasts are funded from the endowment created by the Leibowitz's \$1 million gift. Eligibility to the prize is limited to APA members. The deadline for the nomination form and materials is December 1.

- (1) Two 300 word abstracts. Each abstract should be tailored to address the specific topic to be discussed as well as the approach of the speaker;
- (2) Complete CVs for each proposed speaker;
- (3) At least two letters of recommendation. Ideally, letter writers will have knowledge of both proposed speakers. Letters should address the stature of the candidate(s) and the relevance of the topic for current debates in philosophy.
